Art in the Schools Project at Nicolet Bank Tall Ships®

Green Bay (Feb. 21, 2019) – Eight Northeastern Wisconsin high schools will participate in a new Art in the Schools Project in connection with Nicolet Bank Tall Ships® July 26-28 at Leicht Memorial Park in downtown Green Bay.

Students from Green Bay West, Notre Dame Academy, John Dewey Academy, Oneida Nation, Ashwaubenon, Bay Port, Sturgeon Bay and Algoma will all create art on sails donated by DorSal Sails and Canvas in Sturgeon Bay.

During the remainder of the school year, students will get creative and go to work on putting their unique artistic touch on the sails. This summer the finished products will be prominently displayed during the three days of Nicolet Bank Tall Ships[®].
